I. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF MASTERING THE DISCIPLINE

1. Target mastering the academic discipline “psychiatry, medical psychology” consists of mastering knowledge, skills and abilities in the field of identifying and diagnosing mental disorders, as well as the principles of psychotherapy, biological and drug treatment and prevention of mental illness.

2. Tasks:

- teaching students the ability to identify leading psychopathological signs, symptoms, syndromes, etc.,
- training students in choosing optimal methods of clinical and paraclinical examination for mental illnesses and drawing up an algorithm for differential diagnosis;
- training students to provide first aid to mentally ill patients in the event of emergency conditions in accordance with the standards approved by the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation;
- training students in choosing optimal regimens of biological therapy and drug treatment for the most common mental illnesses in accordance with the standards approved by the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation;
- familiarizing students with the basic methods of experimental psychological research of mentally ill patients;
- familiarizing students with the principles of organization and operation of medical and preventive institutions of various types;
- developing communication skills with patients, taking into account ethics and deontology, depending on the identified pathology and characterological characteristics of the patients.
