**1. The purpose of studying the discipline** Preserving the historical truth about crimes of the Nazis and their accomplices against the civilian population of the occupied territories of the USSR during the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945. The study of the discipline's materials is intended to help students understand the key manifestations of the policy of genocide. Understanding the history of crimes against humanity should draw attention to the universal issues of pacifism and mutual understanding and lead to an awareness of our responsibility as citizens of the world to prevent the spread of Nazi ideas.

## 2. Summary of the discipline

### 1). Section 1: **Introduction. Ideological and institutional foundations crimes against humanity.**

Racial theory and ideology. Nationalist and eugenic teachings of the Nazis as the basis for the policy of extermination of peoples. Preparing Germany for war. Development of mechanisms for the destruction of entire nations. Organizational basis for the implementation of the racist strategy of systematic extermination of the population of the USSR.

### 2). Section 2: **Crimes of the Nazis and their collaborators occupied territories of the USSR. Occupation of Rostov-on-Don and the Rostov region. Genocide as an international crime.**

The role and place of collaboration in the implementation of the Ost plan. Crimes against civilians in the occupied territories of the USSR. Labor service. Sonderkommandos. Crimes against childhood.

Crimes against the civilian population of Rostov-on-Don in November 1941. and in 1942-1943. Zmievskaia beam. Creation of concentration camps for Red Army prisoners of war and civilians on the territory of the Rostov region. Mass deportation of the region's population to Germany. Partisan movement. Contribution of employees, students and graduates of the Rostov-on-Don Medical Institute to the cause of the Great Victory. "Fire Issue".

### 3). Section 3: **Modern falsifications of the history of the Second World Wars.**

Modern falsifications of the history of the Second World War as an attempt to evade responsibility for the genocide of civilians in the occupied territories. Historical memory.
