Conduct an examination of the rectum in a proctological patient. Conduct a general examination of the surgical patient. Wear a sterile gown and gloves (with and without your sister). Determine the suitability of blood for transfusion. Prepare the system for blood transfusion. Determine blood group according to the ABO system. Select instruments, materials and medications for opening the abscess. Select instruments and remove sutures. Select instruments for gastric lavage. Select instruments and medications to stop bleeding from the esophageal veins. Participate in endoscopic studies. Participate in radiology studies. Prepare the sigmoidoscope for use.
