Form of study full-time

#### 1. INTRODUCTORY PART

The goal of mastering the discipline "Practice of Professional Communication" is for foreign students to master the Russian language as a means of communication to the extent necessary and sufficient to solve communicative problems in the educational and professional sphere within the framework of the first level of proficiency in RFL.

This goal is achieved by developing key competencies in foreign students in the field of the discipline being studied:

- language (linguistic) competence;
- speech competence;
- communicative competence in all types of speech activities (listening, reading, speaking and writing).

Course objectives:

to help students master the Russian language as a means of communication in the educational and professional sphere;

- give an idea of the system of the language being studied in terms of the scientific style of speech and teach how to use this system in the process of professional speech activity;
- to form a terminological base of scientific medical vocabulary;
- to develop the speech abilities of students in the process of mastering the language of their specialty;
- develop motivation for further mastery of the Russian language as a means of professional communication.

## II. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RESULTS OF MASTERING THE DISCIPLINE

The process of studying the discipline is aimed at developing the following competencies in accordance with the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education and the EP of Higher Education in the specialty 31.05.01 "General Medicine":

### a) general cultural (GC):

- ability for abstract thinking, analysis, synthesis (GC -1);
- willingness to self-development, self-realization, self-education, the use of creative potential (GC -5);
- readiness to work in a team, tolerance in perception of social, ethnic, religious and cultural differences (OK-8).

### b) general professional (GPC):

- readiness to solve standard tasks of professional activity with the use of information and bibliographic resources, biomedical terminology, information

and communication technologies and taking into account the basic requirements of information security (GPC-1);

- readiness to communication in oral and written forms in Russian and foreign languages for solving tasks of professional activity (GPC -2);
  - readiness to keep medical records (GPC -6).

As a result of mastering the discipline, the student must:

**Know** the language material characteristic of the educational and professional sphere of communication:

- at the phonetic level: pronunciation of polysyllabic words; continuous pronunciation of combinations of consonants in general scientific and terminological vocabulary, as well as at the junction of words; pronunciation of word forms, prepositional-case forms, subject-predicate, passive constructions, complex prepositions;
- at the lexical level, at least 1,300 lexical units;
- at the word-formation level: word formation of nouns, adjectives, verbs,
   compound words and words with related units;
- at the grammatical level: morphology:
- a) the main meanings of cases characteristic of the scientific style of speech;
- b) the use of short forms of adjectives, characteristic of the scientific style of speech; use of adjectives in terminological phrases;
- c) features of the use of verb forms in the scientific style of speech; <u>syntax</u>: types of simple and complex sentences characteristic of the scientific style of speech; composition and subordination in simple and complex sentences.

#### Be able to

- use the studied phonetic, lexical, morphological, syntactic units in various types of speech activity (reading, writing, listening, speaking) in accordance with the speech situation;
- carry out verbal communication in the educational and professional sphere and types of speech activities (reading, writing, listening, speaking) in accordance with communicative needs.
- a) in listening: understand by ear information presented in the form of a monologue statement of an informative and explanatory nature (the topic of the text, its main content, the main information of its semantic parts);
- b) in reading: understand the topic, problem and main content of the educational and scientific text read; main and secondary information of individual semantic parts, logical, cause-and-effect relationships between them and conclusions; use different types of reading (studying, browsing and searching);

- c) in writing: compose a written statement of a reproductive and productive nature based on a text read or listened to; make a plan for the text you read; write down key fragments of the text read or listened to, definitions of concepts, conclusions, etc., using text compression techniques, accepted methods of abbreviating words and symbolism.
- d) in speaking: convey the content of a read educational and scientific text based on the proposed questions or plan; take part in a dialogue-questioning based on the text read, understand the communicative intention of the interlocutor and adequately respond to his remarks.

**Possess** the language, speech and actual communicative material necessary to solve communicative problems relevant for the educational and professional sphere of communication:

- name the object;
- report the presence of an object;
- give a definition of an object/concept;
- give a classification of objects;
- describe an object, process, phenomenon;
- describes the process of observation and research;
- give various characteristics of an object, event, phenomenon;
- describe the composition, structure, properties of the object;
- describe changes in the state of objects;
- express the connection and dependence between objects;
- describe the sequence of actions to obtain the desired result;
- describe the position, location, habitat of the object;
- describe the application, use, purpose, functions of the object.

#### III. THE PLACE OF THE DISCIPLINE IN THE STRUCTURE OF EP HE

**3.1.** The discipline "Practice of Professional Communication" refers to the part formed by the participants in educational relations and is a variable discipline. The training of foreign students is carried out on the basis of continuity of knowledge and skills acquired as a result of mastering the course "Russian as a Foreign Language". It is a prerequisite for subsequent study of professional disciplines in Russian.
